Let's celebrate

This year marks the 40th birthday of Longman's Hill CP School and we are going to be celebrating in fine style. We will be organizing a number of activities with the children to help them mark the school's birthday and to learn about 1977 (some of you may be as old as I am and therefore remember the mid 70s!). We are also planning on having an outdoor party on the last Friday of the half term; more details will follow closer to the time.

Outdoor PE kit reminder

Over recent weeks, the weather has slowly improved which has meant Jack, our sports coach, has been able to plan outdoor PE sessions for the children, which is fantastic. However, some children have been unable to fully participate due to not having the correct kit. **In order to take part in outdoor sessions, children must wear trainers** (not pumps which have insufficient grip on the playground). Please ensure your child has a pair of trainers which they can wear for outdoor PE so they can join in safely. This also prevents dirty pumps then being used for any indoor sessions which may follow if the weather changes. **Children who do not have trainers to wear will not be allowed to participate in outdoor PE lessons for health and safety reasons.** Additionally, children should also have a sweatshirt (not school jumper) and jogging bottoms or tracksuit trousers to put on in cooler weather. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
