PARKING OUTSIDE SCHOOL

We have received **several** complaints from local residents on both Parkways and Myrtle Avenue, as well as parents arriving on foot from our school community, about the inconsiderate (and in some cases, illegal) parking on the roads around school. Drop off and collection times are always very busy times of the day on roads around schools. However, some parents are parking their cars near to the zig zags near the entrance of school or even up on the pavements. This forces parents, some with prams, and also children walking to school unaccompanied, out onto the very busy road which is extremely dangerous.

Whilst enforcing safe and legal parking does not fall within my job role, I would strongly urge parents who drive their children to school to park safely and considerately so that we can keep ALL of our children safe.

Additionally, parents are not allowed to drive into the school car park to drop off or collect children as, again, this causes a safeguarding issue.
