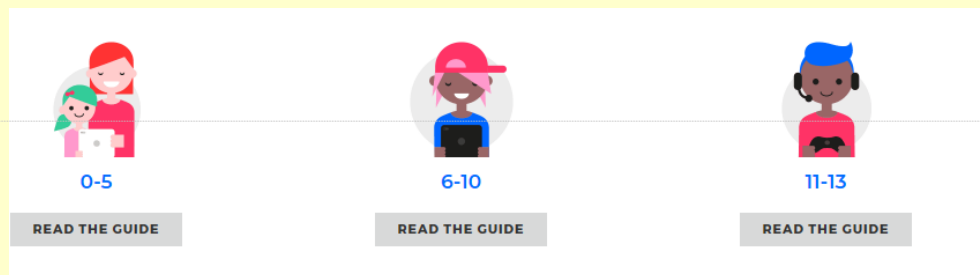
Fortnite Battle Royal Online Gaming- Parent Information

As the latest online gaming craze sweeps the nation, we wanted to make sure parents are fully informed about the game and how to keep children safe. Although the game is rated as appropriate for players age 12+, we know that many of our children, including some in Y1, are playing this game. During the game, children do communicate with strangers as this is a multi-player game. There is concern that games such as these, where children are contacted by strangers, are being increasingly used for grooming children. The latest research shows that almost all children targeted /groomed online are now under the age of 13 and 30% are under the age of 10.
