"North Yorkshire Police want to keep its communities informed with what is going on in their neighbourhoods. By signing on to Community Messenger you could receive regular emails concerning emerging crime scenes, serious incidents that may impact upon the community and details relating to local community engagement. It also provides a facility for you to feedback directly back to the Police Officers and Police Community Support Officers who work in your area. It is very simple to sign up - either visit this Home Page or scan the QR code and fill in some very basic information. You will then get an email asking you to complete sign up and you are away. This is a secure system, your information is not shared with anyone else and you can sign out at any time to. We need to work together and this is a good way of achieving that - Thank You



Reading Success!

Following Mrs Rhodes' letter, encouraging parents to hear children read more often, sent a couple of weeks ago, we have seen a significant increase in the frequency of children reading at home, across all classes. This is absolutely fantastic to see! Children who read daily, become more fluent and pacy in a shorter time period, than other children. National research evidences that children who read frequently perform better in GCSEs. Whilst we appreciate these exams are some years away, it still shows that reading daily is hugely important. Many thanks to all parents and carers who have supported at home with this! Keep it up over the half term holiday and beyond. Thank you!

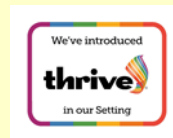
