Dear Parents

Year 6 Residential – PGL, Caythorpe Court Multi Activity Centre

Thank you for the consent form for your child to attend the Year 6 residential to Caythorpe Court in October.

I have attached a medical form for completion and would ask that you return it to school by Friday 15th September.

A clothing list is also attached. Please ensure that you follow the notes carefully. Generally, 'oldish' clothing should be brought which is warm and waterproof. Clothing should be named to avoid losses. A reusable drinks bottle is needed clearly labelled with your child's name.

The coach will be leaving school on Monday 6th November at 10am. Children should arrive at school at the normal time and will do school work as usual prior to leaving. Children prone to travel sickness should take an anti-sickness pill before departing and bring one in a sealed named envelope to give to the teacher for the return journey, along with any other medication included on the medical form.

Children are expected back in school on Friday 10th November by 1pm at which time they will have a packed lunch brought from the Centre to eat. A text will be sent out to confirm that the children have arrived at school and eaten their lunch. If you would like to collect your child before 3.15pm we are happy for you to then do so.

Final payment for this trip should have been made by 31st August 2023.

Mobile phones are not allowed at the Centre. If brought, they will be confiscated.

Staff will send a text to confirm arrival at the centre and also each morning, to update you on how things are going. However, there will not be any other contact or information shared with parents whilst we are away (except in emergency circumstances) This is because the site is quite remote with very little connectivity or wifi. A member of staff would have to leave the children on a regular basis to access wifi at the main reception/office to upload images. We believe it is better and safer for the adults to remain with the children. Please be assured that staff will take lots of photos which we will share (either on the school website or Google Classroom) when we return to school.



Reminder: If your child wishes to bring pocket money, it must be in a named purse/wallet (£10 maximum).
