NCETM's Mastering Number Programme

A big thank you to all the parents and carers who joined their child in school this term for the Mastering Number at home workshops. It was a great turn out. We hope you gained some new knowledge about how maths is taught in schools and feel better placed to support your child at home in their mathematical journey.

The children in Reception and Key Stage 1 will be continuing the Mastering Number programme. We are starting to seeing to really positive results in children's confidence and understanding.

In addition to this, children in Year 4 and 5 are involved in a new programme designed by the NCETM (National Centre for Excellence in the Teaching of Mathematics) which aims to improve children 's understanding of multiplication and therefore recall of the times table facts. Children in these two classes have a short session everyday in addition to their main maths lesson which focuses on gaining a deep understanding of the structure of multiplication.
